<u>Coronavirus Update</u>

School Return

I am sure that you are all aware of the Prime Minister's announcement last night regarding potential school reopening. At present, we do not have any more information than that outlined in his broadcast – namely that we may be looking at a return to school for EYFS, Year 1 and Year 6 pupils, on or after 1st June. Like us, you may have been left with many questions. Unfortunately, we cannot answer them until we have further guidance from the Government. In the short-term, nothing has changed – the guidance in relation to key workers and others who can access school childcare remains the same. I will provide further information in the coming days and weeks, once I am able to do so. I am also working with all the Watford Headteachers to try to ensure a consistent, unified approach, which will give you certainty. As a Head, I want to get pupils back into school as soon as it is safe to do so. We miss them as much as they are missing us. I am also very conscious of the widening gap, the longer they are out of schooling. As teachers and school staff, we have devoted our lives and careers to the care and education of young people – we do not want to see classrooms empty for a day longer than they need to be.

However, our first priority is always the safety of everyone in the school community. We will be carrying out risk assessments and following all Government guidance to ensure that our pupils and families will be safe whenever they do return to us.

<u>Year 6 & Year 2</u>

Today would have been the start of Year 6 SATs week. This is a significant moment in a primary child's life – the culmination of so much hard work. Our pupils worked with dedication and commitment to achieve their full potential in the tests. I'm sorry for them, that they won't get the satisfaction of knowing just how far they've come, or the pride that our children always feel on results day.

However, I want them to know that their success is not measured in an exam – the diligence they demonstrated in preparing for the SATs will stand them in good stead for life; the knowledge they gained will ensure they enter Secondary ready for the next phase of their
