September 2020 Covid-19 Information

What should my child bring into school?

On the first day:

- Pencil case
- Named water bottle
- Indoor shoes (any appropriate footwear can be used if you have been unable to get plimsoles), which will remain in school.
- Lunch box (if required)
- Medication (if required)
- Coat/waterproof
- 2 snacks (fruit or veg only)
- Bookbag (EYFS/KS1) or rucksack (KS2)
- Named wellie boots for EYFS and Year 1 which will stay in school.

On subsequent days:

- Water bottle
- Lunch box (if required)
- 2 snacks (fruit or veg only)
- Coat/waterproof
- Bookbag (EYFS/KS1) or rucksack (KS2)

What if my child forgets something they need?

Mrs Carlon is not going to be able to go into classes to drop off any items or pass on messages. Please only contact the office if the message/item is essential.

Are they allowed to wear facemasks?

Face masks are not allowed to be worn in school. School staff will also not be wearing face masks.

What is the school lunch menu?

- We are currently only having packed lunch options. Children are able to bring two healthy snacks (two pieces of fruit/veg, not cereal bars etc.) – one for the morning and another for the afternoon.

On Monday 7th September, the options will be either a Chicken Korma Wrap or a Cheese and Salad Wrap. This menu will run until October. Children can still bring in their own packed lunch from home.

What should I do if my child feels ill?

- For 'normal' sickness (e.g. tummy upset, colds), please follow the school reporting arrangement of texting the school number. If your child displays Covid symptoms, please keep them and any siblings off school. You should text and email the school and a member of the SLT will call you back.

What will happen if a member of the school community tests positive for Covid-19?

- The Government have set out a clear procedure for if someone tests positive – we will follow this and be guided by Public Health England as to our next steps.
