Early Birds Breakfast Club:

7.40am - 8.50am

WrapAround Care Information

Before using WrapAround Care you must complete a registration form.

Early Birds

Children must be signed in by an adult.

KS1 pupils will be escorted to their classroom at the end of Breakfast Club and handed over to their teacher. KS2 pupils are released from the Hall to go to their classrooms.

Night Owls

Once pupils are registered, the service can be used on an ad hoc basis.

Start Times

The Night Owls Club runs 3.30pm at the end of the school day until either 5.00pm or 6.00pm Monday to Thursday and 1.30pm-4.00pm on Friday, during term time. The club will not operate during School Inset days, on the final day of term or when the school is closed to pupils. A trained coach runs a uni-sex Football Club every Friday from 1.30-2.45pm. Indoor provision includes table-tennis, basketball, table-football and music. Other activities include cookery, arts and crafts, farm and forest time.

Children will be registered in the Hall. KS1 pupils will be collected from their classrooms and escorted to the club, where they will be registered.

Please arrive promptly to pick up your child as the school is locked at 6pm. Collection after 6pm will result in a £10 charge to cover staff overtime. You will be asked to sign your child out of the register at the close of the session. It is important that you let staff know if anyone other than you (the parent/carer) is collecting your child.

School ParentPay

Parents pay for Night Owls in advance, via ParentPay. Payment with Childcare Vouchers will also be accepted (please speak to the school office for more information if you wish to pay in this way).

Ad-hoc Sessions

Parents will have the flexibility to book ad-hoc sessions, where places are available.
